"I didn't do this alone, but I did it with care, precision, and integrity." When we lift each other up, we elevate the entire industry.

## **QUICK REMINDERS**

- Do not post any entries before your country's winner announcement.
- Always use the official credit list.
- · Always credit "Client: Retoucher of the Year Competition."
- Do not alter or reassign credits they are part of a legal and ethical agreement.
- If reposting your work later (e.g., portfolio, website, Behance), please keep the credits visible in the description.
